Buyers can make sales appointments with this season's NEWGEN MEN designers: Agi & Sam, Alex Mullins, Astrid Andersen, CMMN SWDN, Craig Green, Kit Neale, Lee Roach, and Vidur. NEWGEN MEN shoe designer, Diego Vanassibara, will have a stand for the whole four days as part of the Accessories showroom.

Also at Victoria House is the Accessories showroom. This will include shoes such as **Dr**. **Martens**' *Made in England* line and **Kult Domini**'s first menswear collection. **Eye Respect** returns to the Designer Showrooms with its hand-crafted eyewear, and family business **Alfie Douglas** will show its latest fine leather goods. Other brands include watchmaker, **Uniform Wares**, and helmet company, **Hedon**.

This season the Opening Reception will take place at The Hospital Club and is the first chance to see the showrooms. *Seventh Man* magazine and *Menswear Buyer* will host this season's Open Houses at The Hospital Club and Victoria House. These are opportunities for press and buyers
