Mother of Pearl presented their first collection at London Fashion Week in AW14 and Creative Director Amy Powney, joined in 2006; four years after the brand was founded by Maia Norman. Mother of Pearl has been shortlisted for the BFC/Vogue Designer Fashion Fund in both 2015 and 2016 and in the same year the label was awarded the Walpole Emerging British Luxury Talent prize.

London Fashion Week Festival is the ultimate fashion experience, with curated shopping galleries from over 150 international and British brands including Alfie Douglas, French Sole,

Jamie Wei Huang, Jane Carr, Linda Farrow, Paper London, Tada & Toy and Taylor Morris and AW17 catwalk shows from London Fashion Week designers.
