According to art historian Lee Sandstead, Piccirilli was a member of a family of Italian-American marble cutters and sculptors, which first arrived in the United States from Massa-Carrara, Italy in 1888.

For over 40 years, the Piccirilli Studio (founded 1893) in the Bronx, which specialised in carving large stone statues based on small models, was the biggest in America. In this instance, therefore, there was a direct line of tradition to the skills and figurative sculpture of the Italian Renaissance.

Adorning the west face of the cenotaph is a large bronze relief depicting three galloping horses pulling a fire engine. (Originally, this relief had been made from marble but, due to weathering, it was replaced with a bronze version during a 1934 restoration. A further restoration was undertaken by Jan Hird Pokorny Associations Inc., New York, from 1987 to 1992.) Thus, the Memorial combines a scene of early twentieth century firefighting with Renaissance-style, female personifications. On the east face is a relief depicting the mythical
