

I will be exploring a variety of knitting techniques that range across all different machines and gauges. I want my collection to capture the joyful and energetic vibe that 60's skiwear provided. Creating volume and excitement within my garment shapes and fabrics. I believe the contrast between delicate lace and chunky bold knits will bring a new and innovative perspective to my work.


