

Chinese philosophy





For example, walls and openwork windows can add depth, it divide the natural landscape without breaking the connection between two spaces. And when one looks through the windows at a static pace, all the scenery is then in relative displacement. This process is meant to bring the human spirit and nature together and to convey interest and stability.

Creating a divine space - at the heart of which is light (Louis Cohn), light combined with colour and water gives a powerful emotional experience. some Western designers use the creation of dream spaces to add healing. This is based on surrealism, which is based on Freudian psychoanalysis. In dreaming, one temporarily forgets the rational dichotomy of thinking and the suppressed subconscious is released and healed. The search for a spiritual space outside the form, in which one feels like returning to the mother's womb.







The transparent curved medium reflects the surrounding landscape and distorts it. The line between virtual and real is blurred. The familiar landscape is now transformed into a utopian world.










Shape source: Plan of the Zhuo Zheng Garden (a well-known classical Chinese garden). Drawings in AI followed by 3d modelling in C4D















Method of bonding leather and resin: leave groove in the resin section with small holes in the s groove. Stucking the leather into the groove and fix it with male and female screws



#### Source of the shape: Cang Lang Garden
























Materials: resin, leather, metal Size: 30 \* 13 \* 8 (cm) Technology: 3D print, electroplate












# **MATERIALS**



- 1.Coloured resin: using coloured resin 3d printing, its surface becomes smooth and shiny after the treatment.
- 2. Electroplating: internal material white wax. After 3d printing the item is given a bright silver surface by using chrome.





Transparent piece made with 3d printing technology can interact well with light to create beautiful shadows. It has the glossy feel of glass but is much lighter in weight.
