


Turning point Photo Ming Wei China 20 years ago



Modern urban residential buildings in China




At this stage, I think the touch of body, the distance between each other is an important component of intimacy.


When we meet offline, close contact can make us feel each other more fully and affect each other's mood, which increases empathy for each other and promotes intimacy.


Experiment through the change of the distance, I want to show that when we're physically close, increased intimacy can make a person change.

We may seem like an island, but we use the Internet to communicate care, to sustain intimacy, and to support each other. Let us be the land to each other
















