



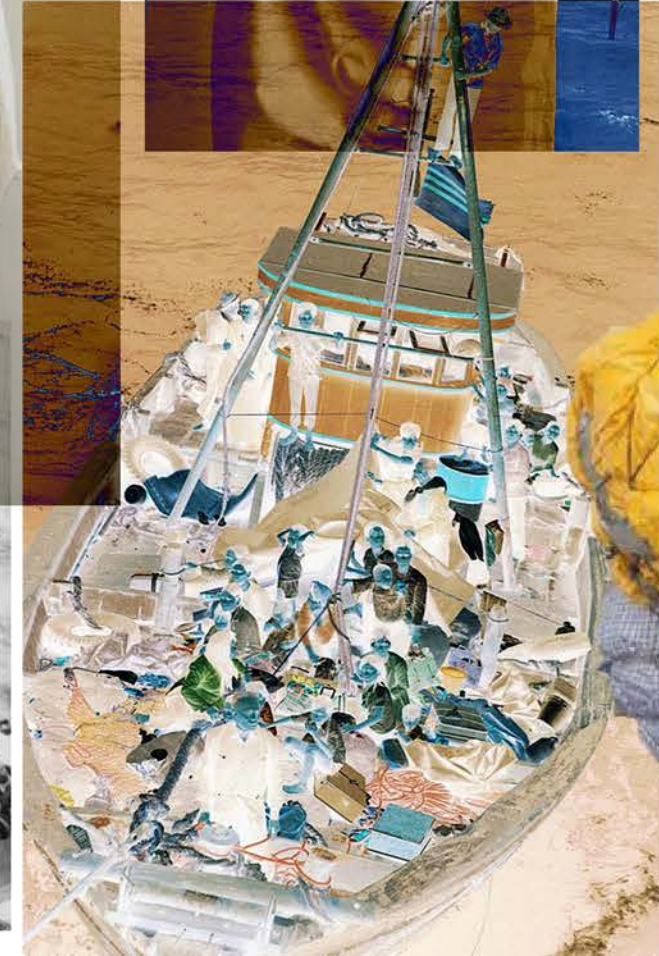

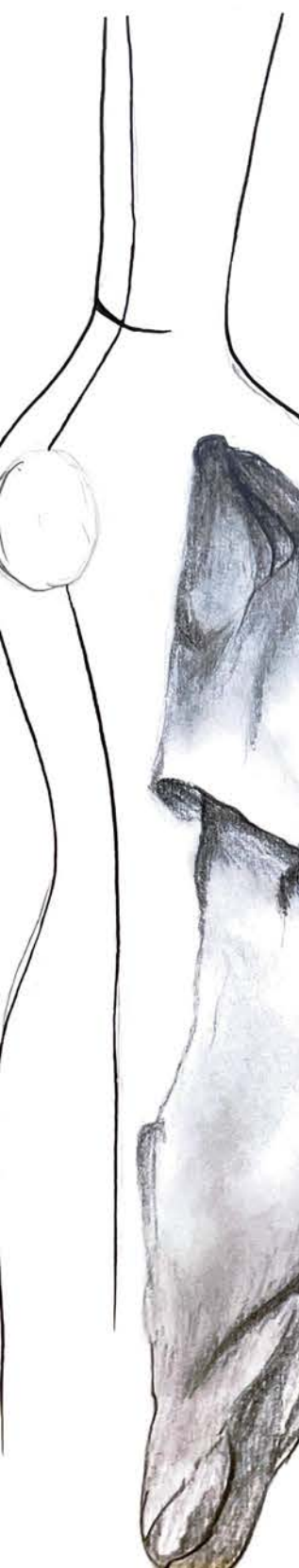




Lines occurring, repeated pattern.

maybe sleeves?

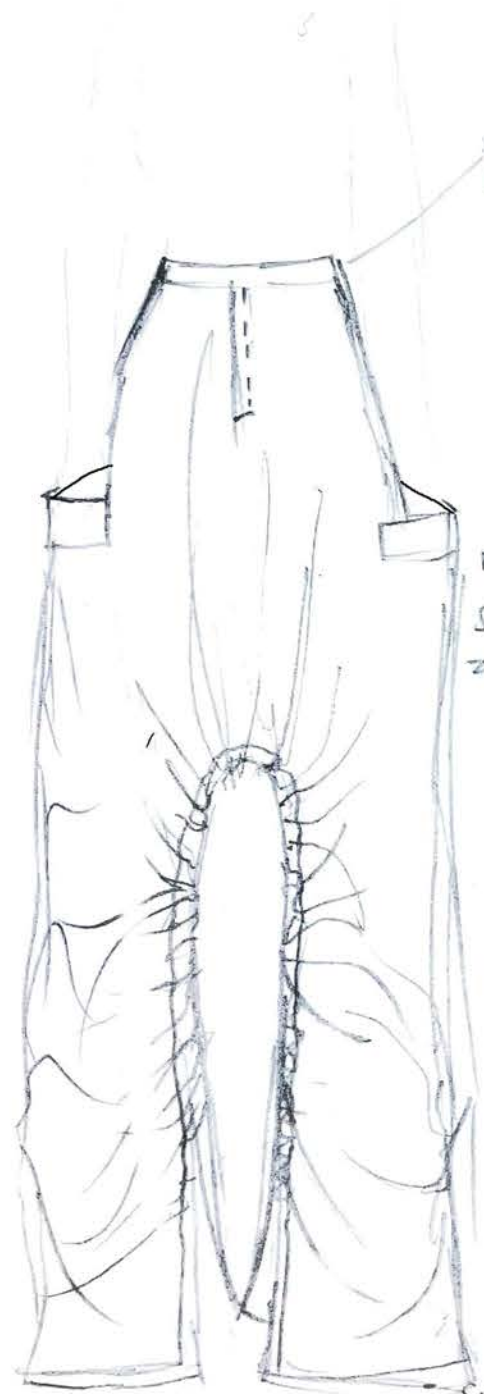


Toile of the back made with letter number 2

To cover the raw edges I would bind it with ripstop nylon fabric.



First toile of trousers was too small fabric was too light wasn't holding shape.

Second toile made it more oversized then I started designing on top of my images to see where I want my details to be
